Dr. Thomas McCarrick has been practicing in geriatrics and family medicine for over three decades. He completed his residency in family practice at Mountainside Hospital, in Montclair New Jersey. One of Dr. McCarrick's long-standing interests has been in healthcare information technology and clinical informatics. Dr McCarrick is also the founder of Care at Home New Jersey, a not-for-profit organization that provides support to home bound adults and their caregivers.
